Greenville Tech Charter High School has been awarded a \$249,914 grant payable over four years to implement a Middle College-Early College program at the school. The Middle College-Early College program is designed to offer students a seamless transition between high school and college allowing students to earn both a High School Diploma and an Associate's Degree in Arts or Sciences, at no cost to the student, within five years of starting high school. The Early College program at GTCHS is designed to provide a rigorous education for all students with academic potential especially focusing on underperforming learners who might not have access to college opportunities. The Middle College-Early Grant is a part of a national initiative to launch over 100 Early Colleges nationwide over five years, beginning in the fall of 2002. The Middle College-Early College High School program is supported by funds from the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation, the Ford Foundation, the Carnegie Corporation of New York and the W.K Kellogg Foundation.
