Greenville Technical Charter High School has been invited to join the Middle College National Consortium to establish early college programs in high school. This concept combines the last two years of high school and the first two years of community college experiences into a seamless academic sequence, which enables students to earn a high school diploma and AA degree in five years, reducing the educational sequence by one calendar year.

Greenville Technical College and GTCHS representatives will be participating in a technical assistance workshop on May 14 and 15, 2003 at LaGuardia Community College, NY. This unique opportunity will allow GTCHS to apply for grant funding from the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation, the Carnegie Corp. of New York, the Ford Foundation, and the W.K. Kellogg Foundation for the fall of 2003.
