

- Greenville Technical Charter High School (GTCHS) was opened in August of 1999 with 200 students
- · Graduation rate: 99% for the past 5 years
- 2020 graduates offered \$6.9 million in scholarships
- 18 Associate degrees were earned by 2020 graduates
- 94% of 2020 graduates enrolled in two or four year colleges. 3 students entered the military
- Mastery Learning requires a grade of 75% or better to earn a Carnegie Unit rather than the traditional South Carolina Grading Scale of 60%
- Student to computer ratio 2:1
- · SC State Report Card Rating: Excellent
- · GTCHS focuses on dual credit and the alignment of high school & college curriculum with the goal that students complete at least one semester of college work before they graduate
