Office Hours:

Purpose: Technical Theatre Arts will continue as an extension of the Set Design club and will learn and apply the technical side of Theatre. Learning how and why the set and costumes provide an important part of a production. As well as how to plan, model and create them. The Technical Theatre Arts class will be designing and creating the set, props, and costumes for the spring musical production of The Beauty and the Beast. This class will have more education and leadership than the club.

Objectives for Technical Theatre Arts:

- To master the Principles and Elements of Design and color theory as it applies to theatre
- To hone technical skills and craftsmanship that creating quality artwork requires.
- To learn how to discuss and critique artwork that is your own, your peers, and famous works.
- To familiarize your self with art and theatre terms that applies in society today.
- To *improve* motor function and hand-eye coordination.
- To practice patience, visual application, and openness to healthy, effective criticism.
- To *create* works that follows a particular rubric and objectives.
- To appreciate the creative process.
- To develop skills required for creative problem solving.

Rules:

- 1. Come to class on time, and prepared
- 2. Listen the first time
- 3. Use class time wisely and efficiently
- 4. Treat others and materials with respect
- 5. Only drinks with a spill proof lid are allowed in the classroom. (No food!)
- 6. You may not be on your phones during class time without teacher permission
- 7. All materials used must be properly cleaned and put away

Rules broken: First offense the student will be asked to correct. Second time Student will be asked to correct, materials may be confiscated, and parent/guardian will be notified. Third time you will be sent to Dr. Gregory to receive a referral.

Chromebooks: Students are expected to have their school provided Chromebook every day to use as their classroom device. All research and digital classwork will be on these devices. Cell phone privileges will be limited to music only and will be taken away if used otherwise.

For Projects I have a late policy: *Late work will have <u>5</u> points taken off every day it is late! (Incomplete work is graded very harshly, so the late work policy is encouraged.)
